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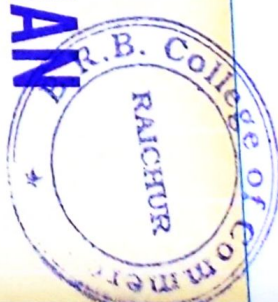

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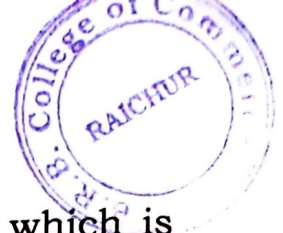
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PREFACE



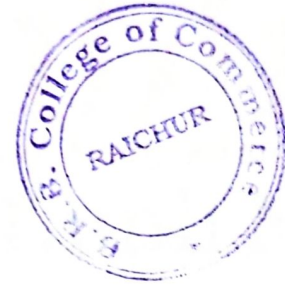
The term "Indian English literature" (IEL), which is sometimes known as "Indian Writing in English" (IWE), refers to the body of work produced by authors based in India who write in the English language, despite the fact that their native or co-native tongue may be one of the several languages spoken in India. Its early history began with the writings of Henry Louis Vivian Derozio and Michael Madhusudan Dutt, which were then followed by those of Rabindranath Tagore and Sri Aurobindo. In the 1930s, R. K. Narayan, Mulk Raj Anand, and Raja Rao contributed to the expansion and popularity of Indian English literature. Additionally, in some instances, it is associated with the works of members of the Indian diaspora who later produce their works in the English language.

The term "Indo-English literature" is often used to refer to this body of work. (The phrase Anglo-Indian should not be confused with the more precise term Indo-Anglian, which is used only in the context of written language). Although some Indo-Anglian works can be categorized as postcolonial literature, the repertory of Indian English literature spans a wide variety of topics and ideologies, ranging from the late eighteenth century to the present day; as a result, it defies straightforward

classification. This literature can be traced all the way back to the time of the British Raj in India.

We welcome comments by readers of **HANDBOOK OF INDIAN WRITINGS IN ENGLISH** for ways to improve the book and to increase its value. Such suggestions will be seriously considered in the preparation of subsequent editions.
